Food Safety

Foodborne illness affects approximately 1 in 6 Americans annually, with nearly half of these cases occurring during the holiday season. To help prevent contamination: Ensure hands are properly washed before food preparation.

- Avoid cross-contamination—keep raw meats, such as turkey, separate from ready-to-eat items like salad vegetables.
- Use meat thermometers to verify safe cooking temperatures. Guesswork isn't enough when it comes to poultry, ham, or turducken.

Fire Safety

Holiday cooking can increase fire risks. Consider the following precautions:

- Keep a fire extinguisher or fire blanket accessible in the kitchen.
- Avoid placing flammable items like tea towels near open flames.
- If frying a turkey, have a clear safety plan in place and discuss it with others beforehand.

Driving Safety

In West Texas, driving fatalities are a frequent concern. Whether traveling near or far:

- Stay alert and recognize signs of fatigue.
- Ensure your vehicle is properly maintained and stocked with emergency supplies.
- Never drive under the influence of alcohol or allow others to do so.

By taking a few proactive steps, we can ensure that our celebrations remain safe and joyful.
